RIGHT

Returns a substring from the end of a specified string.

Sample Usage

```
RIGHT(A2,2)
```

```
RIGHT("lorem ipsum")
```

Syntax

```
RIGHT(string, )
```

`string` - The string from which the right portion will be returned.

`number_of_characters` - - The number of characters to return from the right side of `string`.

Notes

0 is a valid input for `number_of_characters` and will cause `RIGHT` to return the empty string.

See Also

`SUBSTITUTE`: Replaces existing text with new text in a string.

`SPLIT`: Divides text around a specified character or string, and puts each fragment into a separate cell in the row.

`MID`: Returns a segment of a string.

`LEFT`: Returns a substring from the beginning of a specified string.
