FIXED

Formats a number with a fixed number of decimal places.

Sample Usage

```
FIXED(3.141592653,2)
```

```
FIXED(966364281,4,1)
```

Syntax

```
FIXED(number, , )
```

`number` - The number to format.

`number_of_places` - - The number of decimal places to display in the result.

If `number` has fewer than `number_of_places` significant digits, zeros will be appended. If it has greater than `number_of_places` significant digits, `number` will be rounded to the correct `number_of_places` rather than truncated.

`suppress_separator` - - Whether or not to suppress the thousands separator used in some locales (e.g. 1,000 becomes 1000). Separators will be present if this value is 0 or omitted, and absent otherwise.
