To indicate a value as TRUE in Google Sheets, you can either type in the word "TRUE" directly into the cell or use the logical function "=TRUE()". This will return the boolean value of TRUE, indicating that the statement or condition is true.

In most cases, Google Sheets will automatically convert the `TRUE` literal to the logical `TRUE` value, equivalent to this function.
