The ISLOGICAL function in Google Sheets is a tool that allows users to check whether a particular cell contains a logical value or not. This function returns a TRUE or FALSE value, with TRUE indicating that the cell contains a logical value and FALSE indicating otherwise. To use this function, simply enter "=ISLOGICAL(cell reference)" in the desired cell, replacing "cell reference" with the actual cell you want to check. The function can be useful for verifying data accuracy and ensuring that cells contain the expected values.

ISLOGICAL

Checks whether a value is `TRUE` or `FALSE`.

Sample Usage

ISLOGICAL(A2)

Syntax

ISLOGICAL(value)

value - The value to be verified as a logical TRUE or FALSE.

*ISLOGICAL returns TRUE if value is either TRUE or FALSE or a reference to a cell whose value is either TRUE or FALSE.

Notes

This function is most often used in conjunction with IF in conditional statements.

ISTEXT: Checks whether a value is text.

ISREF: Checks whether a value is a valid cell reference.

ISODD: Checks whether the provided value is odd.

ISNUMBER: Checks whether a value is a number.

ISNONTTEXT: Checks whether a value is non-textual.

ISNA: Checks whether a value is the error `#N/A`.

ISEVEN: Checks whether the provided value is even.

ISERROR: Checks whether a value is an error.

ISERR: Checks whether a value is an error other than `#N/A`.

ISBLANK: Checks whether the referenced cell is empty.

IF: Returns one value if a logical expression is `TRUE` and another if it is `FALSE`.
