ROUNDDOWN

The ROUNDDOWN function rounds a number to a certain number of decimal places, always rounding down to the next valid increment.

Sample Usage

```
ROUNDDOWN(99.44,1)
```

```
ROUNDDOWN(A2)
```

Syntax

```
ROUNDDOWN(value,)
```

value - The value to round to **places** number of places, always rounding down.

places - - The number of decimal places to which to round.

places may be negative, in which case **value** is rounded at the specified number of digits to the left of the decimal point.

Notes

ROUNDDOWN operates like ROUND except that it always rounds down.

TRUNC: Truncates a number to a certain number of significant digits by omitting less significant digits.

ROUNDUP: Rounds a number to a certain number of decimal places, always rounding up to the next valid increment.

ROUND: The ROUND function rounds a number to a certain number of decimal places according to

standard rules.

MROUND: Rounds one number to the nearest integer multiple of another.

INT: Rounds a number down to the nearest integer that is less than or equal to it.

FLOOR: The FLOOR function rounds a number down to the nearest integer multiple of specified significance.

CEILING: The CEILING function rounds a number up to the nearest integer multiple of specified significance.
