UMINUS

Returns a number with the sign reversed.

Sample Usage

`UMINUS(-4)`

`UMINUS(A2)`

Syntax

`UMINUS(value)`

`value` - The number to have its sign reversed. Equivalently, the number to multiply by `-1`.

See Also

`UPLUS`: Returns a specified number, unchanged.

`UNARY_PERCENT`: Returns a value interpreted as a percentage; that is, `UNARY_PERCENT(100)` equals `1`.

Examples
