

How to use Google Sheets to translate text using the Google Translate function?

GOOGLETRANSLATE

Translates text from one language into another.

Sample Usage

```
GOOGLETRANSLATE("Hello World", "en", "es")
```

```
GOOGLETRANSLATE(A2, B2, C2)
```

```
GOOGLETRANSLATE(A2)
```

Syntax

```
GOOGLETRANSLATE(text, )
```

`text` - The text to translate.

The value for `text` must either be enclosed in quotation marks or be a reference to a cell containing the appropriate text.

`source_language` - - The two-letter language code of the source language, e.g. "en" for English or "ko" for Korean, or "auto" to auto-detect the language.

If `source_language` is omitted, `target_language` must also be omitted.

`target_language` - - The two-letter language code of the target language, e.g. "en" for English or "ja" for Japanese.
